

KEY OF THREE IN THE OFFICES OF CHRIST (PROPHET, PRIEST, AND KING)

AS PROPHET - Through this office our past tense salvation (of the spirit) was completed.

1. He prophesied by the Spirit and by the Word and by His walk.
2. He was slain outside the city as prophets were
3. It was in His office of prophet that Jesus paid the penalty for our sins
4. This office is typified by the myrrh (an antiseptic gum resin used in burial given by the wise men at His birth.
5. Scriptures: Deuteronomy 18:15, 18-19; Matt 13:57; Matt 21:11; John 19:39.

AS PRIEST- Through-this-office our present tense salvation (of the soul) is completed.

1. He is presently Interceding for us
2. His intercession depends on His own shed blood
3. His Intercession is necessary for us to maintain fellowship with God (1 John 1:9)
4. This office is typified by frankincense (a sweet smelling incense) given by the wise men at Christ's birth
5. Scriptures Hebrews 10 12. 2 1-22. I John 2 1, Hebrews 2: 17, Hebrews 4: 15-16, 8 1, 9 11-15, 1 John 2:1, 1.9; Hebrews 12 24, John 15. 1-2, Hebrews 12. 5..6

AS KING - through this office our future tense salvation (of the body) completed

1. This office begins after Christ finishes His High Priestly duties
2. He will judge all Christians in heaven (2Cor 5:10)
3. At this same time, God will be judging Israel man earthly Judgment through the "furnace of affliction" during the Tribulation Period (Isa 31:9; Zech 13:8-9.)
4. He will judge the world at His Second Coming and will destroy worldly kingdoms and set up His own Kingdom. (Dan 2) All judgment is committed to the Son. (John 5:22)
5. He will reign as King over Israel according to the Davidic Covenant. (2 Sam. 7: 16; 22-29)
6. He will reign as king over the entire earth and all nations He will rule with a rod of iron (Psalm 2; Rev 12:5) The overcomers will also rule with Him over the nations with a rod of iron (Rev 2:26-27)
7. This office is typified by the gold given by the wise men at Christ's birth.
8. Scriptures: 2Cor 4:4; Matt 2:6; Rev 19:11-16; 20:6; Isa 9:6,7; Isa 11; Matt 25:31-32; Zech 14:9; Psalm 89:20-29, 35-37; Dan 2: 34-44; 2 Sam 7:16, 23-29; John 5:22; Rev 12:5; Rev 2:26-27.
