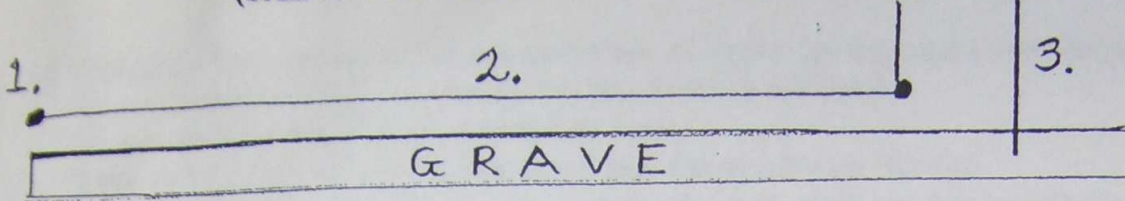


KEY OF THREE IN THE SALVATION OF MAN
(SALVATION OF SPIRIT SOUL AND BODY)



Salvation of Spirit:

1. Past tense salvation---Justification: The demands of the Law against us have been met by the blood of Christ. Christ has paid the penalty for our sins. "We have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ."
2. Saved from the **penalty** of sin—eternal separation from God—Lake of fire.
3. It is a free gift, not of works.
4. Man's spirit is regenerated (born again) when God's Spirit enters and becomes one with man's spirit.
5. Happens immediately, the moment one believes in the Lord Jesus Christ. See Acts 16:30-31.
6. The believer is sealed by the Holy Spirit the moment he believes.
7. The believer is made a child of God.
8. Salvation of the spirit can not be lost. Heaven is assured.
9. Scriptures: Ephesians 2:8-9; Romans 4:5; Acts 16:30-31; Acts 10:43-44; Ephesians 1:13 and 4:30; Titus 3:5.

Salvation of Soul:

1. Present tense salvation—presently in progress.
 2. Saved from the **power** (the downward pull) of Sin.
 3. Begins the moment our spirit is saved.
 4. It is not a free gift, but is based on works of faith which are produced as we live by faith--stay in fellowship with God--abide in Christ--walk in the Spirit.
 5. Can be lost. It is not assured---must be "worked-out" over the lifetime of the believer. Phillipians 2:12-13.
 6. Will be determined at the Judgement Seat of Christ.
 7. The saved soul will be granted reward at the Judgment Seat of Christ.
 8. The soul not saved will suffer loss at the Judgment Seat of Christ—but not the loss of heaven.
 9. Scriptures: Matthew 11:28-30; James 1:18-21; I Peter 1:3-9; Matthew 16:24-27; II Corinthians 5:9-10; I Corinthians 3:10-15; I Corinthians 9:24-27 and 10:1-12; II Timothy 2:2-7; Phillipians 3:7-14; Hebrews 12:1-3; Acts 14:21; Romans 8:17; II Timothy 2:10-13; I Timothy 6:10 and 18-19; Matthew 19:28-29; I Timothy 4:16; Ezekiel 33:9.
- How much surrendered to his will*
- the amount of the soul that is saved will receive reward*
- the amount that is not saved will be burned up.*

Salvation of Body:

1. Future tense salvation.
2. Saved from the presence of Sin.
3. Happens in a moment of time—at the resurrection or rapture.
4. Scriptures: I Thessalonians 4:16-17; Romans 8:23.
